GUERNSEY AIRPORT TO HOST WORLD WAR TWO DAKOTA ON SATURDAY 6 JUNE

Guernsey Airport will be hosting a World War II Dakota on Saturday 6th June 2009.

The aircraft is understood to have taken part in the original D-Day landings on 6th June 1944, and has been participating in the 65th Anniversary of D-Day in Normandy.

The aircraft will be on the main apron at Guernsey Airport from 10am until 12 noon (approximately) on Saturday.

Regretfully there will be no access to the aircraft for the public, but the aircraft will be visible from the northside (spotters) car park at La Villiaze.
