GUERNSEY AIRPORT – TERMINAL BUILDING FACILITIES

Changes are soon to be made to the layout of the catering and retail outlets at Guernsey Airport.

The changes will also address requests from passengers who have asked for improved catering facilities in the departure lounge.

The modifications will see the ground floor cafe becoming integrated into the departures lounge, and the current entrance into the cafe near the flower shop being blocked off. In addition, the changes will also see the creation of an additional retail outlet in the departures lounge, which our existing retail operator will fit out and operate.

As part of this process, the current operator of the flower stall has decided to discontinue his tenancy, however in future flowers will be available to purchase in the shop in the main terminal and also in the departures lounge.

The range of food currently served in the upstairs cafe will be extended to provide improved facilities for those people working at the airport or otherwise attending the airport to collect or drop off passengers.

It is hoped that the works will be completed very soon and ideally before the Easter Holidays.
