

Pavements Project – Exhibition

Members of the public are invited to attend an exhibition on the Pavements Project which is installed in the main airport terminal until mid-July. Thereafter the presentation will be moving to other States sites.

As well as detailing the proposed scheme, the exhibition highlights the findings of a comprehensive environmental impact assessment (EIA) that has now been carried out. This looked at the potential effects of the development, which in most cases were negligible, minor or moderate, and also identified possible mitigation measures to reduce these.

Public Services' project consultants RPS carried out the EIA in conjunction with local organisations and States bodies, including La Société Guernesiaise's environmental management consultancy, Guernsey Water, the Environment Department and Guernsey Museums.

The study looked at the potential impact on the archaeology of the area; traffic and transport; air quality; and noise and vibration. Light pollution; flood risk; the local ecology, environment and landscape; and socio-economic factors were also considered.

Pavements Project – Airfield Closure Consultation

Guernsey Airport is undertaking a consultation with its key users over the potential for runway closures at certain key phases of its major redevelopment programme, due to be undertaken from 2011. Whilst the consultation is aimed primarily at airlines and key commercial operators at the Airport, the consultation is open to anyone, including members of the public.
